Dr Sriya Chakravarti is an education luminary who leads distinguished roles in building better models of applied education through inclusion, digitization, relevant curriculum and entrepreneurship. She believes in doing good work, and promoting a culture of excellence, ethics and engagement.

Sriya holds the MBA and Doctor of Education degrees from the University of San Francisco, USA. Her university is counted among top 500 universities in the world and during her scholarly tenure, she was a recipient of full scholarship and maintained a GPA 3.83 on her doctoral degree. Her dissertation, Healing India Implications for Peace, featured HH Dalai Lama and earns royalties on a periodic basis. Her career is decorated with numerous awards and post nominal like the FRSA, FRAS and PFHEA. The FRSA earlier awarded eminent personalities like Charles Dickens, Benjamin Franklin, Stephen Hawking and Nelson Mandela. The FRAS was conferred previously to Indian doyen Raja Ram Mohan Roy and Rabrinath Tagore. The PFHEA honor is given only to 1 percent of top professors worldwide, who exhibit great leadership in the field of education. Her other prestigious affiliations include chartered membership with the CIPD and Chatham House in the UK.

Her expertise with paperless teaching, online assessments, digital marking and feedback have revolutionized education systems internationally. For her work in digitization of education, she was invited as an expert to a high profile discussion hosted by the Georg Eckert Institute, a UNESCO Prize holder of Peace Education in Germany. This work later translated into the Rethinking Pedagogy Report, where she served as a lead author. The report was disseminated through UNESCO MGIEP and propelled digitization in education of the SAARC nations.

Based on her high level of experience in the field of education, Sriya was appointed as an advisor for new Emirati educators to join the education profession under the National Emiratization Strategy and Nation Building Initiative of the UAE. She also served as a mentor for the New Education Policy of India under the UKIERI initiative. She is on high profile government committees of the Higher Education system of UAE to bring innovation into curriculum through gamification, virtual reality, microlearning, project based learning, phenomenon based learning etc. to improve student learning outcomes. For 100 percent employment on graduation, Sriya worked on a hybrid education framework where all students graduated with both an academic and professional qualification that was valued by employers.

Sriya is the official judge for Reimagine Education, a Wharton University initiative. It is considered the Oscars of Education and is the world's largest awards program for innovative pedagogies and solutions for the greatest problems facing higher education. Sriya has gained tremendous influence and readership through her writings. Her research explores how education can help us create a better future and if technology infused education can truly deliver equality of opportunity and skills. She has directed 750 student research projects thereby contributing to the body of educational scholarship and authored several peer reviewed research papers, chapters, and books. Her articles featured regularly in the education column of the renowned Huffington Post.

As a UN ally and philanthropist, she provides online educational resources for refugees to reskill and find jobs to improve lives through a UN sponsored organization, Rumie.org. As a Thought Leader for UNITAR, she designed courses for a global audience free of charge to upskill during the pandemic. She served as a UN mentor for 25 Indian schools and guided teams with their entrepreneurial aspirations. She partnered with the Royal Asiatic Society of Great Britain and Ireland to support their work on research and scholarships. Her personal enterprises provide employment, fund sustainable micro projects like cowpreneurship, girl dreamer, sankalptaru tree plantation, coral reef restoration in the Indian ocean and support schools with supplies and scholarship in remote villages of the world.

Her innovations are international exemplars referred by numerous reputed entities to impart skills and prepare students for 100 percent employment on graduation. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar National Award of Special Consultative Status by the UN Economic and Social Council recognized her contribution in promotion of social justice and olympism through education. Harvard Graduate School of Education acknowledged her expertise by publishing her thought-provoking pieces on the future of learning. Furthermore, her research has received international coverage through leading US publishing networks.

To summarize, Sriya's uplifting educational leadership pursuits have influenced thousand of students she taught and educators she led.
